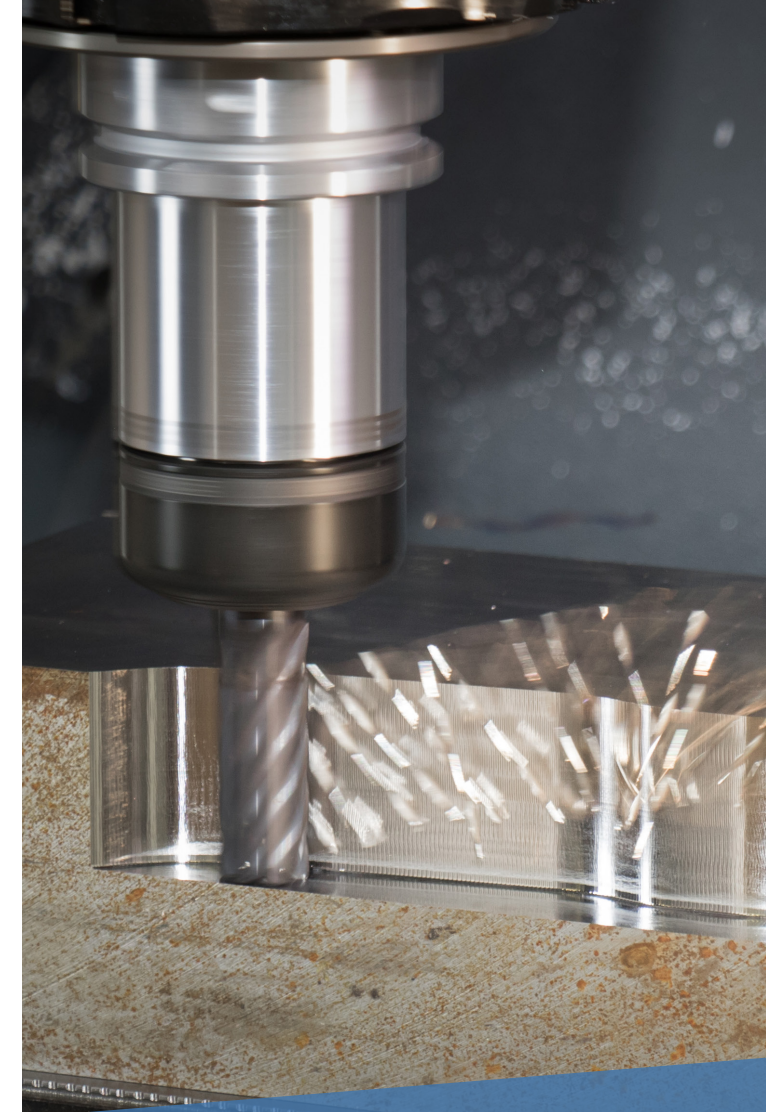

CAREER ADVANCEMENT OPPORTUNITES

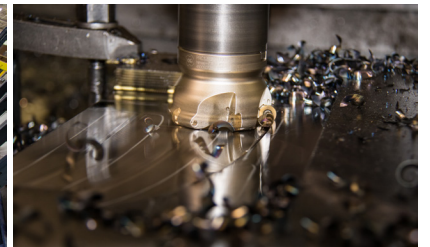
In mold building, you can pursue any path that appeals to you. As you advance further into the trade and complete apprenticeship, journeyman and other continuing education opportunities, your skill mastery and career direction will flourish alongside your earning potential.

MAKE A COMPETITIVE SALARY

On average, entry-level mold builders - after 4-5 years of apprenticeship - can make up to \$16 - \$21/hour (about half that of an experienced mold builder). Although this varies based on experience, geography and skill specialization, most entry-level mold builders make competitive pay, no matter their educational background.

HIGH-TECH, TEAM-ORIENTED ENVIRONMENT

Manufacturing plants are not dusty and dangerous. In fact, mold building facilities are high-tech, fast-paced environments that require advanced training and constant communication and teamwork between designers, machine operators, plant managers and others.
